

Funding Model for FY18 and FY19 (HB49, ORC 3314.08)

Opportunity Grant – Basic Aid

FY18 \$6,010

FY19 \$6,020

This is the basic state aid each student receives.

Tier 1 Targeted Assistance –

Provided to the poorest 20% of districts (taking in to account both property and income)

25% of the resident district's tier 1 targeted assistance for that student.

Special Education –

School receives the following funds in addition to other funds for each child that has an IEP and falls into the following categories. Please note these are the *funding* categories and not SPED categories.

Category

1. Speech Only **FY18 \$1,578** and FY19 \$1,578
2. Cognitive Disabilities, Specific Learning Disability, Developmentally delayed, Other Health Impaired (Minor) **FY18 \$4,005** and FY19 \$4,005
3. Hearing Impaired, Emotional Disturbance **FY18 \$9,622** and FY19 \$9,622
4. Visual Impairment, Other Health Impaired (Major) **FY18 \$12,841** and FY19 \$12,841
5. Multiple Disabilities, Orthopedic **FY18 \$17,390** and FY19 \$17,390
6. Deaf-Blind, Autism, Traumatic Brain Injury **FY18 \$25,637** and FY19 \$25,637

K-3 Literacy Funding –

FY18 \$320

FY19 \$320

Additional funding for each student in grades K-3.

Economically Disadvantaged Funding –

FY18 \$272 times the student's resident district's economically disadvantaged index

FY19 \$272 times the student's resident district's economically disadvantaged index

Limited English Proficiency Funding –

See ORC 3317.016 and ORC 3301.0710 for specific qualifications for this category.

Category

1. Students enrolled in schools in the U.S. for 180 days or less **FY18 \$1,515** FY 19 \$1,515
2. Students enrolled in schools in the U.S. for more than 180 days **FY18 \$1,136** FY19 \$1,136
3. As defined by the department FY18 \$758 FY19 \$758

Career-Tech Education Funding –

Career-Tech funding is based on the student's participation in approved career-technical education programs in one of five categories. Amount range from \$245-\$5,192 for both FY18 & FY19.

Funding depends on which program the student is enrolled. See ORC 3317.014 for specifics.

Facilities Funding –

Site-based community schools are funded \$200 per student for facilities funding. Amount received is actually less than \$200 due to limits on the funds available. It probably **averages about \$195 per FTE in FY18.**

E-School community schools are funded \$25 per student for facilities funding. **Averaging about \$24.50 in FY18.**

Notes:

E-Schools are ONLY ELIGIBLE for Opportunity Grant, SPED and Career-Tech.
