

2019-2020 Virtual School Student College Scholarship Application

The Ohio Council of Community Schools (OCCS) is proud to offer a Virtual Student Scholarship for students who have attended an online school sponsored by OCCS. Scholarships may be awarded for any 4-year college or university (University of Toledo, etc.), 2-year college (Owens Community College, etc.), or trade college leading to a certification (Hamrick Truck Driving School, etc.). This award will be a one-time scholarship ranging from \$500 to \$5,000. If awarded, this scholarship will be available for renewal upon completing a re-application in future years.

I. Eligibility

- a. Students must have attended an OCCS sponsored virtual school for at least one year
- b. A cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher
- c. Completed a standardized admissions test (ACT or SAT), if applying for a 4-year school

II. Deadlines and Documents

To be considered for the scholarship, OCCS requires the following documents to be submitted by 4:00pm Friday, May 10, 2019:

- a. 2019-2020 virtual school student scholarship application (including supporting documents)
- b. Evidence the candidate attended an OCCS sponsored virtual charter school
- c. A transcript indicating the candidate's cumulative grade point average
- d. Standardized admissions test results (ACT or SAT), if applying for a 4-year school
- e. Completed essay

III. Selection Process

Upon receipt of a completed scholarship application and ALL other required documents, OCCS will verify eligibility and review completed applications. Candidates will be notified by May 23, 2019. Please note, incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
